

About the programme

Through this **3-month Public Speaking Programme**, the student will develop confident and effective communication skills. This is an essential skill for success in academics, leadership, and social interactions. This programme will allow the student to articulate their thoughts clearly, structure their ideas logically, and speak with a sense of presence in any setting. Through guided instruction and practice, participants will overcome stage fear, refine their presentation skills, and develop strong self-expression equipping them with lifelong skills for future success.

As the final objective of this course, the student will take the LAMDA (London Academy of Music & Dramatic Art) examination in Speaking in Public and apply their learnings. Upon completing this examination, the student will be awarded a certificate from LAMDA. While highly recommended, this is an optional examination; those not taking the exam will have the same learning journey and an internal assessment.

Certificate from J's Academy will be awarded on successful completion of the programme for that level.

What is LAMDA?

London Academy of Music & Dramatic Art (LAMDA) is a world-leading conservatoire and an awarding organisation, offering world-renowned qualifications in communication and performance through their examinations. They examine over 110,000 learners each year in over 45 countries across the world.

Speaking in Public exam prepares learners for a task that daunts so many people. Learners write their own speeches, researching the topics, creating visual aids, and presenting them from memory.

COURSE INFORMATION

1 At what age can I enrol my child? Are there any prerequisites?

This course is appropriate for students in school grade 2 to 12. Students are grouped with peers of their age and level of development. There are no prerequisites, only the openness to learn.

2. How long is the programme?

This is a 3 month/12 session programme. The sessions are held once a week for one hour —same time every week. After completion, the student may enrol to the next level and continue to develop the skills.

3. What if I do not want to take the LAMDA exam?

Yes, the LAMDA examination is optional and the learner can opt to not take it. This will not impact their learning and they will take an internal assessment at the end of the programme. However, we recommend taking the exam as the student will be prepared for it and many other advantages of performing in front of an examiner and getting the certification.

4. Can I miss the exam this year and then take the exam in the following year?

You can take the exam appropriate for your age whenever you are ready - there is no requirement to take all the levels / previous level exams to appear for the current applicable exam.

5. Can I join the programme after the start date?

We cannot accommodate new admissions once the programme has started.

6. What if the student misses a session?

There are no make up turns. The onus of missed learning is on the student. Their facilitator will assist them to help catch up.

7. What is the fee for this programme?

Please reach out to us for fee details, as they differ based on levels. No refunds once enrolled.

8 Can the parent / guardian sit in the classroom?

We do not permit parents / guardians to sit in the classroom or observe from outside the classroom, as this is a safe space for children to explore and work with the teacher and their peers. You may reach out to the faculty for any concerns.
