A programme that combines participating in a theatre show (NCPA) along with community-driven environmental action (Beach Warriors).

The **Perform-A-Play** Programme is a holistic and immersive theatre education programme designed to develop a solid foundation in the fundamentals of stage performance. Through a progressive curriculum, students will engage in audition/interview techniques, character analysis, subtext interpretation, improvisation, performance techniques and ensemble-based play work. Under the guidance of a theatre educator, participants will **apply their skills within a professional auditorium setting staged at NCPA**.

Along with this, towards the script the students will also undertake a real **beach cleanup** with Beach Warriors — carrying the story off the stage and turning awareness of ocean pollution into action.

Limited student intake — each grade brings a themed script to life- Neelu the Whale, 99 Whales and Just a Drop in the Ocean, building over three months to a **live performance at NCPA**.

Dual certification from J's Academy and Beach Warriors — counts toward CAS points for IB students and strengthens university applications and resumes.

A platform to raise audience awareness of climate change, and a chance for every student to become a global citizen through theatre.

Experiential Learning

In-class practices- individual and group tasks such as but not limited to physical and vocal techniques, characterisation, script readings, ensemble work, dialogue work, imaged setting.

Transferable Skills

Soft skills include, but not limited to projection, articulation, spatial awareness, team work, performing in front of an audience, self expression, stage presence etc.

Application

Opportunities to apply the skills in class and outside the classroom such as but not limited to In-class Performance, Dress Rehearsal, Stage Showcase.
